New beads: Button Bead®



Button Bead® has a flat surface and a pointed end. It can be easily combined with seed beads. The pointy end makes it easy to include in many designs and basic stitches. Height approx 4mm, bottom part approx 4.5mm. Packed by 300 pcs.

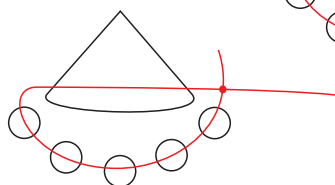

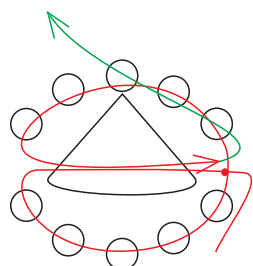

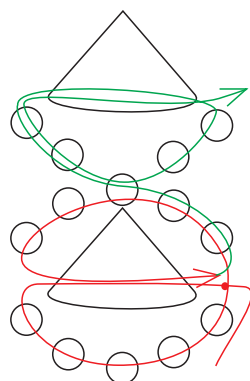

Step 1. Put nylon thread on needle and on it 5M a 1B - connect into the ring. Fasten well.

Step 2. Stitch back and put on needle 5M. Sew into B and the first 3M.

Step 3. Put 2M, B and 2M on needle. Stitch into last M (middle one of five beads added in step 2) and the first two added M and B.

Step 4. Put on needle 5M and again stitch into B and the first 3M. Repeat until reaching desired length.

Keep in mind Swarovski bicone you will add on circuit in next steps would constrict your jewel.

Step 5. Connect last and first B in the moment you reach desired length. Put 2M on needle and go through middle one of five beads from beginning. Add 2M and go back into last B. To fasten your work you can stitch few M around so, that your nylon is coming out of middle hole of Button.

Step 6. Stitch the first M behind hole B, put S on needle and stitch into last M in front of hole of next B. Put M on needle and stitch into the first M behind hole. Repeat until you stitch over all ring.

Step 7. Stitch into beads to reach opposite side of ring and repeat complete step 6. Stitch through beads to beginning of thread on the end, fasten well and sew thread edges into your work to hide them.

Same steps can lead to make much more: earrings, ring and bracelets as well.

Number of Button Beads is up to your size.

There are 2 rings like on earrings (with 5 Button Beads) used on necklace. Slight deviation on other rings on necklace: there are Swarovski Bicone 3mm (4 for each one) instead middle Button beads and added M 8/0 on circuit on peripheral rings. And there are Swarovski Bicone 4mm instead middle Button Beads (6 psc) and added Rizo beads on circuit of central ring.
