Bracelet, 7.5 inch (19 cm) without clasp

5 a 11/0 seed beads

7 g drop beads 3.4 mm

8 g Rizo

2 Jumprings

1 Magnetic clasp 10 mm

FireLine 6 lb. Needle size 12.







Wanna be a Butterfly














Step 1

Take a double wingspan of thread. Workingthread and thread end should have about the same length. String each one drop, size 11°, Rizo, size 11°. Repeat another 2 times and make a ring. Reinforce the round and exit from a drop bead.

Step 2

String one 11°, one Rizo, one 11° and pass through the following drop bead. Repeat 2 more times. Step up through the following 11° and Rizo.

Step 3

String one 11°, drop, 11° and pass through the following Rizo. Repeat 2 more times. Step up through the following 11° and drop bead.

Step 4

Repeat the steps 2 and 3 until there is about 20 cm thread left. End with a step 3. String one 11° and pass through the following drop. Repeat 2 more times. Reinforce the beads of this step to tighten them up. Then attach the loop of the clasp to this end. Secure the thread and cut it off.

Continue with the other thread end with a step 3. Then alternating step 2 and 3 until the bracelet has the desired length. Repeat step 4 here and attach the other clasp end. Secure the thread and cut it off.
