

The first element is finished. You can add a loop to mount it to a chain.

If you want to make a bracelet, you can make several units and attach them with links made of firepolished beads.



MATERIALS

supplies (per unit)

1 Bartel Element Lasercut round 27mm

48 firepolished beads 4mm

2g Spacer beads size 11° Miyuki

3g seed beads size 11°

2g seed beads size 15°

FireLine 0,12mm

Beading needle size 11°

For one bracelet of 19cm/ 7.5 inches you need 4 units plus a clasp


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


















Step 1

Exit from one hole from the lasercut upwards. String 3 size 11° and pass through the next hole down. String 3 size 11° and pass through the first hole upwards. Proceed to the second hole and repeat the step until the entire round is bezeled in this way (figure 1 and 2).

Step 2

Exit from the middle 11° of one group of three. String two size 11° and pass through the middle bead of the next group of three on that same side. Repeat another 15 times to complete the round. Exit from the first 11° added in this step (figure 3).

Step 3

String one 11° and pass through the following two 11° of step 2. Repeat 15 more times to complete the round. Exit from the first 11° added in this step (figure 4).

Step 4

String one firepolished bead and pass through the following 11° added in step 3. Repeat 15 more times. Exit from the first firepolished in the end (figure 5).

Step 5

String one 11° and pass through the following firepolished bead. Repeat 15 more times (figure 6)





Step 6

From now on the beaded rows will bend around the outline. Exit from a firepolished bead. String one spacer bead, one size 15°, one spacer bead and pass through the next firepolished bead. Repeat 15 more times. In the end, exit from one 11° added in step 5 (figure 7).

Step 7

String two size 15°, one 11°, two 15° and pass through the next 11° of step 5. Repeat 15 more times. Exit from the first 11° added in this step (figure 8).

Step 8

String one firepolshed and pass through the following 11° added in step 7. Repeat 15 more times (figure 9).

Step 9

Weave back to the base and repeat the steps 2 through 7 on the other side. Then zip both outlines by weaving along the 11°s of the second side and the firepolished beads of the first side (figure 10).

Step 10

Exit from a firepolished bead, string one spacer bead, one 11°, one Spacer bead and pass through the following firepolished bead. Repeat 15 more times to complete the round (figure 11).
